ORACLE ARTIST STUDIO TOUR

Artists Eligibility and Responsibilities

Eligibility

-Our goal is to feature the work of Oracle Artists. Artists **must** either have a studio or create their artwork in the historical town of Oracle.

-Artists must show their work in their homes, studios, or in an *approved art venue.

* Please contact OAST if you would like to show at a location other than your studio. Artists may offer to share their studio space with other approved participants.

Artists who do not create their art in Historical Oracle are not eligible to participate in the tour.

Responsibilities

-Artists must submit their completed application and fees by **February 10th, 2025**. The application fee is \$60 and includes publication on the OAST website, brochure, advertising, and signage for the tour. **Applications received after this date will not be eligible to participate. Once your eligibility is verified and application is accepted, the application fee is non-refundable.**

-Artist must email two to three photographs of their work to oraclearttour@yahoo.com for publication on the OAST website, www.oracleartiststudiotour.org. Photos should be clear and cropped and must be labeled with the artist's last name, title of the work and medium. Three dimensional pieces should be photographed with a neutral background.

- Optional: Artists are encouraged to send photos of themselves working in their studios for publication on the "In the Studio" page on the website.

-Artists are required to be present in their studios on Saturday and Sunday from 10am-5pm.

-All artwork must be original and created by the participating artist. Artwork produced by another party or the resale of manufactured goods is not permitted.

-Only artists that have applied, paid their fee, and have been approved are allowed to participate. Participants cannot invite outside artists.

-All artists are required to volunteer. You may be contacted by the OAST committee for your help. If you have any special talents or interests, please let us know! All participants are required to pick up and distribute at least 25 flyers.

-You will be emailed a draft of the brochure for proof reading. Please check that all your information is correct and reply if needed. Failure to do so may result in inaccurate information being published in the brochure and on the website.

-Artists must pick up and return tour location/yard signs so they can be used the following year.

-Our OAST coordinators volunteer their time and talent without monetary reimbursement.

- All fees collected are used for OAST expenses only.
